How to enter

- 1. **Register** to attend the free Let's Ride Bristol 2018 at www.letsride.co.uk/events/bristol. Get an adult to help. Adults can register on a child's behalf. (Teachers/parents: children can easily be added on when an adult registers.
- 2. **Download** the '*Design a Dream Bike*' blueprint from <u>www.letsride.co.uk/events/bristol</u> or ask your teacher for it.
- 3. **Design your bike**: colour in and add bits to your dream bike. Get creative and have fun!
- 4. **Fill in** your name, age, your school and email address ask an adult to help. No home email? Just write down the school email address.
- 5. Scan and send in your bike design, or photograph it. Email it to Joe at designabike@britishcycling.org.uk. (Still designing on the day? Just make sure you register for Let's Ride Bristol, then hand in your design to the 'Go Ride' zone, near College Green on event day!)
- 6. Join us! See you at Let's Ride on Sunday 8 July. Bring your bikes or hire ours.
